# Live in a Housing & Residential Life Co-Op

Housing & Residential Life is proud to offer two housing properties for graduate students and students with families. Both properties are owned by the University and are independently managed as cooperatives.

Residents may choose to join the cooperative as stockholders. Responsibilities include:

Cleaning common areas as scheduled

Participating in co-op governance and activities

Residents may opt-out of the cooperative. These residents pay a slightly higher rental rate.

## **Co-Op Eligibility:**

- Degree seeking students
- Postdoctoral Fellows (job code 9560)
- Postdoctoral Associates (job code 9546)
- Medical or dental residents
- Professionals in training employed under a limited set of job codes

## **Tenant Prioritization:**

- 1. Graduate & Undergraduate Families, Domestic Partners, with or without children
- 2. Individual graduate students
- 3. Post-doc families
- 4. Individual post-docs

## **Application & Waitlist:**

- Each co-op uses a separate application and waitlist.
- There is often a waitlist, so apply early!
- Applicants are not required to pay a security deposit while on the waitlist.
- No credit check required.
- No co-signer required.

### **Roommates:**

- Single students may live at either co-op by themselves or with a roommate.
- The co-ops do not provide assistance with roommate pairing or placement.
- The roommate does not have to be a student.
- At least one resident must be a student.
- The co-ops do not rent by the room. The rent amount is for the entire apartment. Roommates are responsible for arranging their own payment agreement between each other.
